Order of Worship

How God has worked in the world as revealed in His Word is called redemptive history and can be divided into four categories: creation, fall, redemption, consummation (when Jesus returns). Our order of worship moves us through redemptive history, reminding us of the gospel as we worship. We have changed the final category from consummation to benediction, since we still eagerly wait on the Lord's return.

Lord's Supper

Jesus gave the Lord's Supper as a means to strengthen the faith of those who have made a public profession of belief in Him. We believe the elders have been given the responsibility of caring for our souls in part by knowing the profession of faith in Jesus of all who eat and drink. Every member of the Treasure Valley RPC has shared their faith with the elders. If you have not met with Pastor Ryan before the service, please reflect on Jesus' death as the bread and cup are passed and seek to talk with him after the service so that you might partake next week.

- Global Mission Board: Pakistan
 - The Christmas celebrations of believers in Pakistan play an important cultural role in a society where believers are a very small religious minority. Protestants are seeking the Lord's wisdom regarding thoughtful ways of bringing a Biblical witness into public spaces in ways that will illuminate the spiritual meaning of the Incarnation.
 - Political controversies have polarized Pakistan as the nation draws closer to national default on their IMF loans. Pray for many Christian and secular activists pressing for religious liberty within the country.

- Two elders from the Chaura congregation will join a week-long mission into southern Punjab province. The team will explore evangelism opportunities among another minority religious group in that area and other church planting possibilities. Pray for safety, for harmony among team members, and for fruitfulness in preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- A heart-broken family in the Chaura church wandered away from the faith about eight years ago, due to the sudden death of the mother and the mental illness of the father. But praise God: the three children have returned to the town, and are now rebuilding their house across the street from the church building. Pray the congregation might show the love of Christ through practical service to this family.
- Pray for Dr. EM as he prepares sermons, lectures, and seminars for an upcoming trip. Ask the Lord to providentially arrange various meetings and opportunities for gospel ministry.
- Please pray for our printing project as we have sent three book drafts over to a printing company run by two Muslim brothers. As they work on these books, pray that God may open their hearts and eyes to see the glory of Christ. Also, please pray that the books will be prepared for distribution before our upcoming trip. The books include: *The Crown of Creation* and *The Bible and Mary*, both by Dr. EM; and *The Lord's Day* by Joe Pipa.

Elder

Now the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: "Speak to the children of Israel, that they turn and camp before Pi Hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, opposite Baal Zephon; you shall camp before it by the sea. For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, 'They are bewildered by the land; the wilderness has closed them in.' Then I will harden Pharaoh's heart, so that he will pursue them; and I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army, that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD." And they did so.

Congregation

Now it was told the king of Egypt that the people had fled, and the

heart of Pharaoh and his servants was turned against the people; and they said, "Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us?" So he made ready his chariot and took his people with him. Also, he took six hundred choice chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt with captains over every one of them.

And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued the children of Israel; and the children of Israel went out with boldness. So the Egyptians pursued them, all the horses and chariots of Pharaoh, his horsemen and his army, and overtook them camping by the sea beside Pi Hahiroth, before Baal Zephon.

And when Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians marched after them. So they were very afraid, and the children of Israel cried out to the LORD. Then they said to Moses, "Because there were no graves in Egypt, have you taken us away to die in the wilderness? Why have you so dealt with us, to bring us up out of Egypt?"

Is this not the word that we told you in Egypt, saying, 'Let us alone that we may serve the Egyptians'? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than that we should die in the wilderness." And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace."

Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him. Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.
